We feel very strongly about protecting our volunteers on our property, which is private and also protecting our volunteers off the property. This is referred to a direct and indirect according to our laws.

Therefore, by signing this pledge, you will admit to being informed of the following;

- 1. Challenge the authority or competence of an umpire, manager, coach or board member.
- 2. Incite abuse, both physical and verbal, and or disrespect of any coach, manager, umpire, parent or board member.
- 3. Intimidate any umpire or openly make negative comments relative to a call, especially in front of any player.
- 4. Make comments (profanity) or gestures intended to be personal in nature to a player, coach, manager, umpire, parent or board member.
- 5. Making negative comments to any player (harassment or taunting).
- 6. Posting negative comments about coaches, umpires, players, parents, fans and board members on social media sites such as Facebook, Twitter and Instagram.

Any coach, manager, umpire or board member may stop any game and request the offender to stop and/or be removed from the property. The highest ranking board member shall take charge and a report shall be filed with the entire board for possible further action. We hope we never have to enforce any of the rules, however after some coaches and fans actions in the past years; we had no choice but to put **ZERO TOLERANCE** into effect.
